Development update

We are delighted to announce that construction of the first stage of Everleigh has recently commenced.

The team have been busy planning and refining the design of the development, and we are excited to see our vision for Everleigh coming to life over the coming months.

We will be delivering extensive new community infrastructure in the first stage of the development. This includes the first stage of the regional recreation park, which will be approximately 1.5ha in size. Within this park there will be a junior playground and a community events lawn at approximately 3,600m² in size. The early delivery of the first stage of the park will provide exciting new community infrastructure in Greenbank for existing and future residents to connect and enjoy.

The first stage of works will also include a linear park which will run alongside the main entry road. This will provide a relaxing green open space, with walking and cycle paths connecting the key activity nodes of the Greenbank Shopping Centre, new regional recreation park, and planned State Primary School within Everleigh.

The first stage of the development, including the linear park and first stage of the recreation park, is anticipated to be completed by early 2019.
